FORMAT

- 24 hours of tennis on 2 courts
- Participating schools responsible for filling a 4hr time slot
- Mixing in with Davis Cup / Fed Cup pros
- Only 2 players from each school would play at any given time

PARTICIPANTS

- 12 schools in total
- School pupils - any age, any standard
- 4-8 players per school

FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENTS

- No minimum requirement but:
- Reach £5,000 fundraising and receive a school 'Davis Cup Open Day' including tennis masterclasses and Q&A

- Great tennis in a fantastic venue
- Encourages pupil fundraising responsibility - possible Duke of Edinburgh volunteering activity?
